Regulations

All applicants will be considered regardless of race, color, religion national origin, sex, or age. Students who would like the Rock Hill Turner Foundation to consider financial need and their family situation are encouraged to apply. Only one scholarship will be awarded per student. If an applicant has a family member who is on the Rock Hill Turner Foundation Board; the member will recuse his/herself from proceedings regarding the scholarship selection.

Requirements

Eligibility – A high School senior, college undergraduate, graduate student who have applied to, been accepted to, or be attending a college or university and plan to pursue, or are currently pursuing a STEM (science, technology, engineering, and math) field. A high school graduate/GED recipient who has applied to, been accepted to, or be attending a trade school or certificate program and plan to pursue, or are currently pursuing a STEM (science, technology, engineering, and math) field.

Include official transcripts from all educational institutions, high schools, colleges, and universities.

Provide two letters of recommendation from individuals unrelated to the student such as an employer, clergy, member of school faculty or volunteer organization.

All applications must be typed, signed, scanned, and submitted electronically Transcripts can be scanned and submitted electronically. Essays must be submitted electronically.

Include a 350–500-word type essay about a) What STEM degree or discipline certificate are you pursuing? How will you give back to the community when you finish your education? (b) Will AI impact your education and career, how?

Sign and date a hard copy of the original documents for the application. Mail it to the Rock Hill Turner Foundation, (address TBA) with a copy of a photo identification.
